Dear Mr. Smith:

I make this request pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.

The submission from the BC Forest Industry Working Group on Climate Change to the Western Climate Initiative's subcommittee on reporting answered the subcommittee's questions on whether third party verification of emissions should be required by saying:

"The Working Group believes that the WCI should not require mandatory verification. Rather, an approach similar to regulatory reporting should be embraced that requires regulated sectors to self report carbon using defined protocols and tools. The jurisdiction would have the right to audit the data as they do today in BC regarding all emissions reporting."

This request is for any documents originating since January 2005 that discuss audits, data audits, or other reviews of industrial air-emissions, and for any documents that discuss audits of emissions reporting in BC in the context of the BC Forest Industry Working Group on Climate Change's submission to the Western Climate Change's subcommittee on reports.
